Tournament Rules

- 1) U.S.B.C Rules will apply to this tournament.
- 2) Bowlers can participate only once except as follows: Substitutes may bowl as many times as they are needed to insure full lineups.
- 3) Each bowler's average shall be that of the 2008-09 season and shall be his highest average in any league in which he bowled that season. A minimum of 21 games must have been bowled to establish that average. If a bowler has no 2008-09 average, his current 2009-10 average may be used if 21 games have been bowled prior to February 6th. A bowler with no previous season's league average or no current season league average, but has a league average from 2006-07 or 2007-08 must enter the highest average of the two seasons. If the average of those two seasons is unknown, he must enter this tournament with an average of 170. A bowler with no current season average and no league average for the previous three years must enter with a 150 average.
- 4) The Team Captain must certify all averages and other information appearing on the application.
- 5) Each team will receive a handicap of 80% of the difference between its average and 1000, but the maximum handicap will be 200 pins per game.
- 6) Any person bowling in the Tournament who is not a K of C member will cause the team to be disqualified and barred from future tournaments.
- 7) All three games will be bowled on the same set of lanes. **Request to be paired with another team must be made at the time of entry.**
- 8) Teams may qualify for only one prize. If a team qualifies for more than one prize, _____, the prize _____ paying the largest cash amount will be awarded.
- 9) EACH TEAM CAPTAIN WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THE SCHEDULE AND STARTING TIME.
- 10) The five(5) man team members must be listed in the order in which they will bowl. Score sheets are prepared in advance and in that order. Any changes in order must be reported at least two weeks before the team is scheduled to bowl.
- 11) It shall be each bowler's responsibility to certify the accuracy of his average for this tournament.
- 12) The requirement to report previous tournament winnings is waived. Rule 319E and the 10 pin rule is waived.
- 13) USBC Moral Tournament Sanction applies and provides for high score protection for those who have established membership in the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). Eligible nonmembers may qualify for USBC award recognition by purchasing a USBC affiliate membership card before participation.
- 14) **Special Attention: Entries Close Midnight February 6, 2010, and must be post-marked by that date. No entry fees will be returned after that date.**
